1. The institution must have affiliation to concerned **State Board** for the above courses before making admissions. In the absence of such affiliation this letter of approval shall be treated as withdrawn.
2. No admission shall be made by the institution, contrary to the guidelines issued by the AICTE for the academic session 2006-07. All the admission must necessarily be made through Entrance Test.
3. The approved course(s) shall commence as per the academic calendar of the **Affiliating State Board**
4. If this letter of approval is received by you after the closing date of State / National Level Central Counseling for admissions in the concerned State/ Union Territory, this letter of Approval will not be valid for making any admission during the above specified academic year, and shall be treated as withdrawn.

5. No excess admission shall be made by the Institution during any academic year.
6. The institution should strictly adhere to the policy framework of AICTE from time to time.
7. The approval is valid only for the academic year as mentioned in the table. If no further extension of AICTE approval is received beyond the academic year, this approval letter will not be valid for making any admission for the subsequent years.
8. Any other conditions (S) as may be specified by AICTE from time to time.

Consequent to the Supreme Court judgement, the Model Constitution of Governing Body notified by AICTE in its approval Regulations, 1994, stands overruled. It has been decided that while AICTE will not insist on any nomination in the Governing Body of Private Unaided Institution, the Affiliating State Board / Government shall impose minimum conditions of affiliation, such as, prescription of qualifications of Governing Body Members, in order to insure academic excellence. It shall be desirable for the private unaided institutions to induct at least 50% of the members of the Governing Body drawn from renowned academics, academic administrators, subject experts and professionals from industry in order to seek their innovative ideas for continuous improvement in the delivery of teaching learning process, matching best practices elsewhere and achieve excellence.

Please note that the Council would verify the status in respect of recruitment of faculty and rectification of other deficiencies through Surprise Inspection without any prior intimation. The institution shall be liable for strict action including action under the relevant provisions of Indian Penal Code in case false information is furnished to the Council.

The Council has decided to undertake inspection without any prior notice before extending approval for the year 2007-08 anytime after August 2006. A compliance report in respect of conditions/ deficiencies mentioned below, must be sent to the Council before start of the session 2006-07 in the absence*whereof extension of approval for the year 2007-08 may not be considered.

The Compliance Report to be submitted to the Council before start of the session 2006-07 also be accompanied with a Visiting / Processing fee (in case of self financing institutions) as prescribed by the Council in the form of Demand Draft in favour of the **Director Technical Education** payable at the place as specified by the State Govt. In the absence of the processing / visiting fee, the compliance report may not be entertained.

It may please be noted that consequent to judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court delivered on 31.10.2002 in TMA Pai Case, the AICTE had issued interim policy regulations, which has been notified in the Gazette of India on 20.3.2003. All the provisions contained in the interim policy regulations shall be applicable in respect of all the AICTE approved institutions.

In the event of infringement /contravention of non-compliance of the above Conditions and/or the provision of AICTE Act & Regulations/ Guidelines/ Norms & Standards as prescribed by AICTE, further actions leading to "Reduced Intake" no admissions or Withdrawal of Approval, may be taken by AICTE and the liability arising out of such actions will be solely of the Management of the Institution.



No technical institutions of government, government aided or private (self financing) shall conduct courses of programs in technical education and no new course or programs shall be introduced and no increase and/or variation of intake in the existing courses/programs shall be effected at all levels in the fields of 'Technical Education' without obtaining prior approval of the council.

Procedure for Extension of approval to existing institutions:

- a) The AICTE approved technical institutions shall submit a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosure information to the concerned director of technical education of the concerned state govt./UT and a copy to the concerned Regional Office of the council by 31ST August every year.
 - b) The institution shall also submit an undertaking in the prescribed format stating that the information provided in the Compliance Report is factual and correct and that the council can take appropriate action, including withdrawal of approval, if it is found that the information provided in the compliance report is false.
1. a) The Compliance report shall be placed before the State Level Committee comprising:

1) Secretary of Higher Education/Technical Education of the concerned State/UT/or his Nominee not below to level of Professor/Director/VC of a University.	Chairman
2) Regional Officer of AICTE or a AICTE representative not below the rank of Deputy Director/Reader or equivalent.	Member
3) Two(2)Subject Experts to be nominated by the State govt./UT Administration from within the State/UT or outside the State/UT.	Member
4) Director of Technical Education / State Board of Technical Education of the concerned State/UT.	Member Secretary
 2. a) Based on the recommendations of the State Level Committee the Regional Officer of AICTE shall issue letter for extension of approval/rejection letter.
 b) The approval to all the existing technical institutions shall be communicated by 30TH June every year.
 c) In those cases where extension of approval is denied for non-fulfillment of norms, & standards and conditions as may be stipulated by the council, grounds of denial shall be communicated to the institution.
 3. In case Extension of Approval is not granted, the institution can make an appeal with documentary evidence to substantiate the claims made and the appeal shall be heard by the following committee (Appellate):
 - The chairman of the AICTE Regional Committee as Chairman
 - Two members not below the rank of Professor to be nominated by the chairman AICTE as members.
 - Director of Technical Education of the State Govt./UT as member
 - Regional Officer of AICTE as Convener.

Based on the Recommendations of the Appellate Committee letter of extension/rejection shall be issued by the Regional Officer of AICTE on behalf of the Council.

4. Random visit may be organized by the Director of Technical Education through Expert Committee any time for verifying the status of maintenance of norms and standards by the institutions.

The Expert Visiting Committee shall comprise of the following members:

- Three Expert members not below the level of Associate Professor/Reader.
- Regional Officer of the AICTE or a AICTE representative not below the rank of Dy. Director/Reader or equivalent.
- Director Technical Education of the concerned State Govt./UT or his nominee not below the rank of JT/Dy. Director level as Convener.

5. a) The Technical Institutions shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/Programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet shall be made available to the stakeholders of the Technical Education on cost basis. The information booklet shall be revised every year incorporating latest information on all aspects of the institution.
- b) It shall be mandatory for the technical institutions to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
- c) If a Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/or misrepresent the information, appropriate action including withdrawal of AICTE approval could be initiated.

Procedure for introduction of new courses or Programmes and for variation/increase in the intake capacity of the existing courses.

Stage-I Submission of Proposal

The AICTE approved technical institutions may submit a proposal for grant of approval for introduction of new courses or programs and or increase/variation in the intake capacity, in the prescribed format along with the following documents to concerned Director of Technical Education of the State govt./UT and a copy to the Regional Office of AICTE.

- A copy of the Compliance Report along with Mandatory Disclosure submitted.
- Detailed Project Report along with relevant document.

Stage-II Verification of the Proposal

- The proposal shall be scrutinized by a committee comprising experts including Regional Officer of AICTE as members and Director of Technical Education or his nominee as Convener.
- Deficiencies if any, shall be communicated by the Director, Technical Education of the concerned State/UT intimation under intimation to the Regional Office of AICTE to the applicant institution within 15 days from the date of receipt of the proposal.

Stage-III Evaluation of Proposal

The proposal shall thereafter be considered by the State Level Committee whose composition is as mentioned above.

- Based on the recommendations of the State Level Committee, the Regional Officer of AICTE shall issue a letter of approval/rejection for introduction of new courses/programs and/or increase/variation of intake capacity.
- The approval accorded by the AICTE shall be valid for two years from the date of issue of letter of approval. It shall be the responsibility of the applicant institutions to obtain necessary permission/affiliation for admission of students from the concerned Admission Authority/State govt./UT/Board during the validity of the period of approval. In case the institution fails to start the approved programs during the validity period of approval, the applicant institution shall make a fresh application.
- In those cases where approval is denied for non-fulfilment of norms, & standards and conditions as may be stipulated by the council, grounds of denial shall be communicated to the concerned institutions.
- In case approval for introduction of new courses/programs and /or increase/variation of intake capacity is not granted, the applicant institutions can make an appeal with documentary evidence to substantiate the claims made and the appeal shall be heard by the appellate committee whose composition is as mentioned above.

Based on the recommendations of the Appellate Committee the Regional Officer of AICTE shall issue letter of approval or rejection for introduction of new courses or Programmes and/or increase in intake and/or variation in the intake capacity.

The decision on grant of approval or otherwise shall be communicated to the institutions.

Cases where approval is denied on the recommendations of the Appellate Committee grounds of denial shall be communicated to the concerned Applicant Institution.

In case the proposal is rejected based on the recommendations of the Appellate Committee, the Applicant Society/Trust shall make a fresh Proposal.

In case of Govt/ Aided institutions introduction of any additional course shall be subject to the fulfillment of the conditions mentioned below:



No technical institutions of government, government aided or private (self financing) shall conduct courses of programs in technical education and no new course or programs shall be introduced and no increase and /or variation of intake in the existing courses/programs shall be effected at all levels in the fields of 'Technical Education' without obtaining prior approval of the council.

Procedure for Extension of approval to existing institutions:

- a) The AICTE approved technical institutions shall submit a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosure information to the concerned director of technical education of the concerned state govt./UT and a copy to the concerned Regional Office of the council by 31st August every year.

2. a) Based on the recommendations of the State Level Committee the **Regional Officer of AICTE** shall issue letter for extension of approval/rejection letter.
- b) The approval to all the existing technical institutions shall be communicated by 30th June every year.
- c) In those cases where extension of approval is denied for non-fulfillment of norms, & standards and conditions as may be stipulated by the council, grounds of denial shall be communicated to the institution.
3. In case Extension of Approval is not granted, the institution can make an appeal with documentary evidence to substantiate the claims made and the appeal shall be heard by the following committee (Appellate):
 - **The chairman of the AICTE Regional Committee** as Chairman
 - **Two members** not below the rank of Professor to be nominated by the chairman AICTE as members.
 - **Director of Technical Education of the State Govt./UT** as member
 - **Regional Officer of AICTE** as Convener.

Based on the Recommendations of the Appellate Committee letter of extension/rejection shall be issued by the Regional Officer of AICTE on behalf of the Council.

4. Random visit may be organized by the **Director of Technical Education** through Expert Committee any time for verifying the status of maintenance of norms and standards by the institutions.

The **Expert Visiting Committee** shall comprise of the following members:

- **Three Expert members** not below the level of Associate Professor/Reader.
 - **Regional Officer of the AICTE** or a AICTE representative not below the rank of Dy. Director/Reader or equivalent.
 - **Director Technical Education** of the concerned State Govt./UT or his nominee not below the rank of JT/Dy. Director level as Convener.
5. a) The Technical Institutions shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/Programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet shall be made available to the stakeholders of the Technical Education on cost basis. The information booklet shall be revised every year incorporating latest information on all aspects of the institution.
- b) It shall be mandatory for the technical institutions to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
- c) If a Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/or misrepresent the information, appropriate action including withdrawal of AICTE approval could be initiated.

Procedure for introduction of new courses or Programmes and /or for variation/increase in the intake capacity of the existing courses.

Stage-I Submission of Proposal

The AICTE approved technical institutions may submit a proposal for grant of approval for introduction of new courses or programs and or increase/variation in the intake capacity, in the prescribed format along with the following documents to concerned Director of Technical Education of the State govt./UT and a copy to the **Regional Office of AICTE**.

- A copy of the Compliance Report along with Mandatory Disclosure submitted.
- Detailed Project Report along with relevant document.

Stage-II Verification of the Proposal

- The proposal shall be scrutinized by a committee comprising experts including **Regional Officer of AICTE** as members and **Director of Technical Education** or his nominee as Convener.
- Deficiencies if any, shall be communicated by the **Director, Technical Education** of the concerned State/UT intimation under intimation to the **Regional Office of AICTE** to the applicant institution within 15 days from the date of receipt of the proposal.

Stage-III Evaluation of Proposal

The proposal shall thereafter be considered by the State Level Committee whose composition is as mentioned above.

- Based on the recommendations of the State Level Committee, the **Regional Officer of AICTE** shall issue a letter of approval/rejection for introduction of new courses/programs and/or increase/variation of intake capacity.
- The approval accorded by the AICTE shall be valid for two years from the date of issue of letter of approval. It shall be the responsibility of the applicant institutions to obtain necessary permission/affiliation for admission of students from the concerned Admission Authority/State govt./UT/Board during the validity of the period of approval. In case the institution fails to start the approved programs during the validity period of approval, the applicant institution shall make a fresh application.
- In those cases where approval is denied for non-fulfilment of norms, & standards and conditions as may be stipulated by the council, grounds of denial shall be communicated to the concerned institutions.
- In case approval for introduction of new courses/programs and /or increase/variation of intake capacity is not granted, the applicant institutions can make an appeal with documentary evidence to substantiate the claims made and the appeal shall be heard by the appellate committee whose composition is as mentioned above.

on the recommendations of the Appellate Committee the Regional Officer of AICTE shall issue order of approval or rejection for introduction of new courses or Programmes and/or increase in intake and/or variation in the intake capacity.

The decision on grant of approval or otherwise shall be communicated to the institutions.

Cases where approval is denied on the recommendations of the Appellate Committee grounds of denial shall be communicated to the concerned Applicant Institution.

If the proposal is rejected based on the recommendations of the Appellate Committee, the Applicant Society/Trust shall make a fresh Proposal.

In case of Govt/ Aided institutions introduction of any additional course shall be subject to the fulfillment of the conditions mentioned below:

1. Submission of Undertaking from Secretary Technical Education/ Director Technical Education of the State Govt./or any other authorized Govt. official stating that the said Programme shall not be run on self-financing basis.
2. Letter from the Secretary, Technical Education / Vice Chancellor /UGC/ Funding agency, regarding the budgetary provision made and posts sanctioned for the said programme.
3. Letter from the Vice-Chancellor/ Secretary, Director Technical Education about the provision made for faculty.
4. Letter from the Vice-Chancellor/ Secretary, Technical Education about the provision made for the operational funds required for the said DTE programme.

It may please be noted that the AICTE has issued interim policy regulations, which has been notified in the Gazette of India on Nov 28, 2008. All the provisions contained in the interim policy regulations shall be applicable for all the AICTE approved institutions.


